

# SOCCER PARENT/COACH CONDUCT AGREEMENT

This form is to state in advance the expectations of adults as pertaining to conduct during soccer events. All parents and coaches are required to sign this form prior to the 1<sup>st</sup> game of the season. Failure to do so may result in your child not playing soccer with PEFYA.

## Coaches

1. No Coach shall speak to any opposing teams player in any format other than praise.
2. Coaches should remember that many of the referees are still children themselves. Your conduct to them should always be respectful. You should also remember that we are participating in youth sports, not collegiate or professional level competition. No “BAD” call by any official will likely effect the games overall results: Except those inside the penalty box. Please refrain from engaging in any confrontational behavior with the referees.
3. As Coaches your team players and parents look to you as leaders; Please act accordingly.

## Parents

1. As a parent you are responsible for proper conduct of yourselves and any guest that are present on behalf of your child.
2. Parents shall not speak to referees except in a positive manner. Parents should also refrain from speaking negatively to any opposing teams players, parents or coaches.
3. Support your team but remember that you should permit your teams Coach to provide specific coaching instructions during all games and practices.
